What are cookies?

Besides creating an overview of the statistics of use of websites, Google Analytics can be, together with several other files, be used to view more relevant advertisements and measure interactions with viewed advertisements. Google Tag Manager	This tool serves as an aggregator of scripts and orders, launched under the new rules. Google Tag Manager itself uses cookies exclusively to identify the website, into which it was entered.
hasContent	Stores information if the visitor granted consent to use cookies.
